Tsunami: In most cases a Tsunami Warning and Advisement will be received by the school. In this event the school would assemble at the PEP ASSEMBLY AREA (Top of 8th Street)

*PEP: Provincial Emergency Program

Tsunami Evacuation Procedures:

- P.A.: "We have received a Tsunami Advisement. Evacuate. Evacuate. Evacuate."
- Evacuate building using normal FIRE DRILL EXITS and ASSEMBLE by class in the middle of the field.

Sweep Team report to office immediately.

- Sweep Team remain in building to assist with evacuation of Special Needs Students.

Sweep Team: **Kevin May; Radio, **Stephen Querengesser**; First Aid, **Megan Romas**; First Aid*

- Scouts determine if EVACUATION ALLEY (8th Street) is clear.

Scouts: **Deavlan Bradley, **Debi Laughlin***

- Positive: Notify Sweep Team and evacuate school from field to PEP Assembly Area.
- SEAs report directly to School Secretary

*PEP Assembly Area Site Office: **Maureen Benoit**, **Kevin May**, **Deavlan Bradley**; Administration, **Megan Romas**, **Stephen Querengesser**, **Sheila Wigmore**; First Aid*

- Classes will be reformed and attendance taken. Report to School Secretary.
- SEAs report directly to School Secretary

The school will remain in the PEP Assembly Area Point and await instructions.

Tsunami Evacuation:

1. A Tsunami Advisement will be announced over the P.A. System.
2. Collect classroom class lists and Red Handbook.
3. Evacuate building in a calm, quiet, orderly manner, following the instructions given by teachers or monitors to the designated assembly point.
4. Follow predetermined evacuation routes. Be prepared to use alternate exits or routes if planned routes or exits are blocked.
5. Assemble in the middle of the field and wait for further instructions. If instructed to do so: Move to the designated EVACUATION ASSEMBLY AREA, steer clear of any overhead power lines.
6. Check attendance and give Secretary the YELLOW SCHOOL EVACUATION RESPONSE FORM.
7. Wait for further instructions.
