QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected and to hold office as a Trustee if:

- he/she is a Canadian Citizen; 18 years of age or older;
- a **resident of BC** for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- is not disqualified by the School Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.
