January 25th attended the PAC Meeting at GidGalung Kuuyas Naay Topics discussed included: 1.) **Supreme Court Decision**

In the weeks following the January Public Board Meeting, I attended the following meeting and events:

January 31- Meeting with the Living and Learning Board in the QC district office with Trustee Goetzinger, Superintendent Johnson Day and Secretary-Treasurer Sansome. The meeting discussed sharing resources and preparing a smooth transition for high school students into the public system.

February 06- Regular In-Camera Meeting in the QC District Office with all trustees and senior staff in attendance. This was the first meeting since November and the number of items to consider precluded time for work on the Strategic Plan at this meeting.

February 20- Labour Management Meeting in the QC District Office with executive from the local and provincial CUPE and SD 50 management representatives. Joint Job Evaluation, the Draft Social Media Policy and the 2017-18 School Calendar were among the items discussed.

February 22-8th Annual Early Learning Forum (K'uuga daahl<u>G</u>ahlda – Change of Heart) on Resiliency at Sk'aadgaa Naay Elementary. The day began with an inspiring and engaging address from Dr. Evan Adams, First Nations Health Authority Chief Medical Officer. I was disappointed to have missed Tom Kertes' workshop, "Superhero Play" due to a medical appointment but it got rave reviews from those who did attend. I returned to attend "Growing Great Kids (Emotional Literacy)" with Michelle Prouty and Nadine Jones. There were also hands-on concurrent workshops with other local presenters.

This was one of the best forums I have attended and kudos are due Tawni Davidson and her team for its excellent content, organization and environment.

Early Learning is the foundation for success in school and it is gratifying to see how much progress Haida Gwaii has made over these past eight years.
