Public notice is hereby given to the electors of School District No. 50 that an election by voting is necessary to elect **ONE** candidate for School Trustee in **Area 2: NORTH**.

**General Voting** for School Trustee will be open to qualified electors of **Area 2** on **Saturday**, **October 15th, 2022**, between the hours of **8:00am** and **8:00pm** at the **Howard Philips Community Centre**, 1590 Cook Street, Masset.

An **Advance Poll** for School Trustee will be open to qualified electors of **Area 2** on **Wednesday, October 5th, 2022**, between the hours of 8:00am and 8:00pm at the same location

#### **ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS**

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form at the voting place.

**Resident electors** must produce **two (2) pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). *Picture identification is not necessary, but the identification must prove both residency and identity.* 

**Non-resident property electors** must produce **two (2) pieces of identification** (<u>at least one with a signature</u>) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property and, if applicable, **written consent** from other owners of the property.

### **RESIDENT ELECTORS** *must be:*

- age 18 or older on general voting day and a Canadian citizen; and
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and not disqualified under the *Local Government Act or* any other enactment from voting in an election; and not otherwise disqualified by law.

## **NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS** *must be:*

- age 18 or older on general voting day; and a Canadian citizen;
- a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- a registered owner of real property in the local Trustee Electoral Area for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration;
- not entitled to register as a resident elector anywhere in Haida Gwaii;
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law;
- if there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.
