We honour the two main dialects of Haida language; <u>X</u>aad Kil, spoken in <u>G</u>aw Tlagée (Old Massett) and <u>X</u>aayda Kil spoken in Hl<u>G</u>aagilda (Skidegate).

We accept the responsibility to manage and care for the education of the children of Haida Gwaii and will work with others to ensure that the natural and cultural heritage of Haida Gwaii is passed on to future generations.

Speaking kindly and listening thoughtfully. We respect each other and all living things. We take only what we need, we give thanks, and we acknowledge those who behave accordingly.

Reciprocity is an essential practice for interactions with each other and the natural and spiritual worlds. We continually give thanks for the gifts that we receive.

GIID TLL'JUUS / GIID TLL'JUUS - BALANCE

The world is as sharp as the edge of a knife. Balance is needed in our interactions with the natural world. Care must be taken to avoid reaching a point of no return and to restore balance where it has been lost. All practices on Haida Gwaii must be sustainable.
