Sony Music Canada \$9000 Grant for Daaxiigan Sk'adää Née

As part of this initiative, two BC-based schools, H. J. Cambie Secondary and Daaxiigan Sk'adää Née, along with Ensemble Non Profit, have been awarded MusiCounts grants of musical instruments and production equipment, thanks to the support of *Beyond The Instrument*. This donation equips students with the tools they need to explore and develop their musical talents and includes a range of traditional instruments and state-of-the-art music technology, ensuring that young musicians can engage in both performance and music production. The investment aims to break down financial barriers to participation, allowing more youth to benefit from the power of music education.
